



RULES AND BY-LAWS

*Old Hickory Council, BSA/Camp Raven Knob
Historical Association*

ARTICLE I

Name, Affiliation, and Purposes

Section 1. **Name.**

The name of the Association shall be the Old Hickory Council, B.S.A./Camp Raven Knob Historical Association and the Association shall be established effective January 1, 1994.

Section 2. **Affiliation.**

The Old Hickory Council, B.S.A./Camp Raven Knob Historical Association, hereafter referred to as the “Association”, shall be affiliated with the Old Hickory Council, Inc., Boy Scouts of America, a nonprofit corporation with registered offices in Winston-Salem, North Carolina. The Association shall be under the direct administrative authority of the Old Hickory Council Executive Board.

Section 3. **Purposes.**

The purposes of the Association shall be to make available and/or to publish historical information concerning the Old Hickory Council, Boy Scouts of America, and Boy Scout Camp Raven Knob; to preserve and to protect historical information—including manuscripts, documents, photographs, and memorabilia—related to the operation of the Boy Scouts of America in northwestern North Carolina; to develop, to establish, and to operate a Boy Scout museum at Camp Raven Knob or at another appropriate location; and to encourage fellowship among Scouts and Scouters based in a knowledge of the rich local, national, and international history of the Boy Scout organization.

ARTICLE II

Membership

Section 1. **Regular Members.**

All regular members of the Association shall be registered Scouts or Scouters with the Boy Scouts of America.

Section 2. **Types of Members.**

There shall be two types of regular members—annual members who pay dues annually, and lifetime members who pay a one-time fee.

Section 3. **Other Membership Requirements.**

Other than registration with the Boy Scouts of America and payment of Association dues, there shall be no requirement for membership.

Section 4. **Honorary Members.**

The Executive Committee of the Association shall bestow honorary membership upon individuals who may or may not be registered Scouts or Scouters with the Boy Scouts of America.
